The following represent questions from participants which were answered directly by panelists within the Zoom Question & Answer Box:

Anne, what skills were new and you had to learn once you stepped outside of the lab?

Anne Walsh-Feeks - Stony Brook Medicine

Hi Nancy. I had to understand hospital operations and how other departments function. Mostly, I had to learn how to be an effective communicator and how to get my thoughts across in meetings. And also, very importantly, how to manage staff at all levels.

Mike, what are some examples of using Chat GPT to help you excel professionally or to help be more efficient/effective?

Mike Eller - Northwell Health Laboratories

- Hi! Thank you for the question a few ways:
- 1) Long email chains...you can cut and paste the whole email chain and ChatGPT will summarize it for you.
- 2) Meeting minutes record meetings and AI will summarize the meeting and list the follow up items. Now I can pay attention in meetings instead of taking notes.
- 3) Business models I like to "explain" what I am trying to do and it gives me suggestions on different business models.
- 4) When I can't quite communicate what I am trying to say...it can give you suggestions. I use AI to help with my thought processes and see things that I may miss. It's like having your own personal assistant.
- 5) There are AI tools like NotebookLM that can help you be more efficient. For example you can upload a contract and just ask it questions, and it will find the spot in the contract you need...so I don't have to read the whole contract again.
- There are so many uses and opportunities...try it! Just be aware of your organizations policies on protected health information (PHI)."
