Vanessa, do you have students from other biological science majors switching over to MLS after being exposed to some MLS courses? Thanks.

Vanessa Jones Johnson – Louisiana Tech University

Yes, we do. We have 19 hours of MLS courses available through being in the Biological Sciences department and 16 are at the junior/senior level. These courses are electives for students in Biology, Pre-Med/Pre-Dental, Environmental Science, Nursing and Health Informatics. We usually get 1-2 students from our classes of 20-40 students that will change their major to MLS.
